

Using LITERATURE RESOURCE CENTER (Gale)

Full-text access to biographies, bibliographies, and critical analyses of authors from every age and literary discipline.

You will need a valid HCC Student ID/Library card number and PIN to access this database.

1. **Click Online Article Databases**
2. **Click** inside the **Borrower ID** box to activate the cursor. Enter your Student ID/Library Card number (starts with “27777...” or “HCC...”).
3. **Click** inside the **PIN** box to activate the cursor. Enter the last four digits of your Social Security Number. Wait a moment.
4. **Scroll down** and **click** on **Literature**.
5. **Scroll down** and **click** on **Literature Resource Center (Gale)**.
6. **Click** on **Connect to Database**. You will now see the **Literature Resource Center** database search screen. It offers various ways to find biographical information about authors, and bibliographies and literary criticism of their works.

Try one of these searches: Author, Title, Author by Type or Advanced Search. At the bottom of any screen, you may **click Help** for tips on search and retrieval options. **Search Tips** gives advice on how to construct your searches for better results. **Research Guide** offers steps to follow in conducting literary research--including how to prepare your works-cited page!

To Print an Article: **Click Print**, on the the left-hand side of the screen, to produce a clean, “printer-friendly” version of the article. You may then **click File/Print** on your browser toolbar to print the article.*

To find another article: **Click Back** on your toolbar until you return to the list of articles—OR **scroll** to the top of the screen to start another search.
