

Using **OMNIFILE FULL TEXT MEGA EDITION (Wilson)**

A multi-disciplinary database containing full-text articles on a variety of subjects including art, biography, business, education, humanities, literature, law, library science, and social sciences. Books reviews and articles from popular magazines are also included.

You will need a valid HCC Student ID/Library card number and PIN to access this database.

1. **Click Online Article Databases**
2. **Click** inside the **Borrower ID** box to activate the cursor. Enter your Student ID/Library Card number (starts with "27777..." or "HCC...").
3. **Click** inside the **PIN** box to activate the cursor. Enter the last four digits of your Social Security Number. Wait a moment.
4. **Scroll** to and **click** on **General**.
5. **Scroll** to and **click** on **Omnifile Full Text Mega Edition (Wilson)** .
6. **Click Connect to Database**. After a few moments you will see the database search screen.
7. In the **Find** box, type your main subject. Any additional term(s) to narrow your search may be typed in the box below. You may limit your results to only full-text articles by *clicking* the **Full Text** box. You may also limit by date. To begin your search, *click* on **Start**. The activated searchlight indicates your search is in progress.
8. The **Results list** will include articles that match your search terms. *Click* on the title of an article to review an abstract or summary, if available. If the article is available in full text, *click* the PDF Full Text or HTML Full Text links to view it. You may print the article or e-mail it to yourself to use later.

If using library computers, printing is **FREE**. **Please print** only the items that will be helpful to your research. This will help us to keep our costs down.
